Before all the other work begins, an architect designs the new house and draws pictures of it.

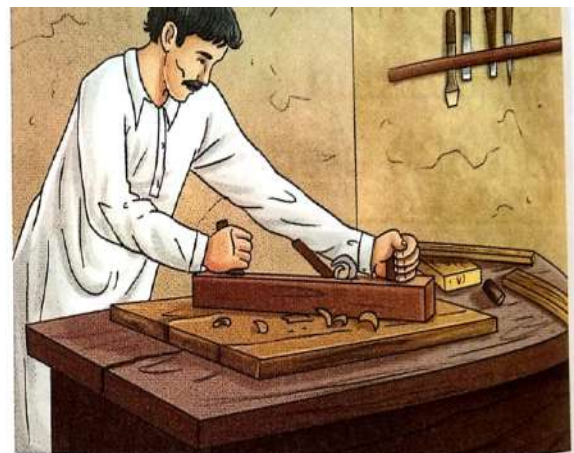
