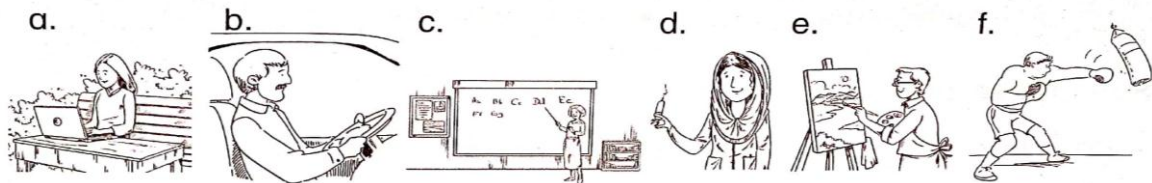

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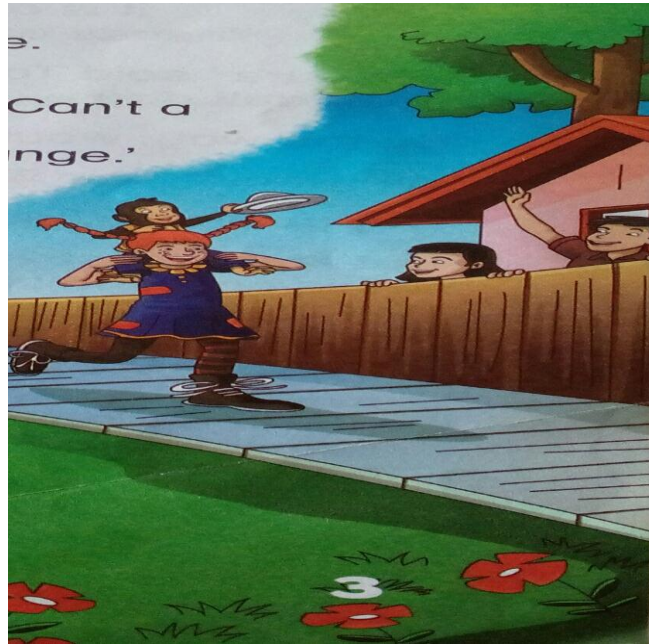

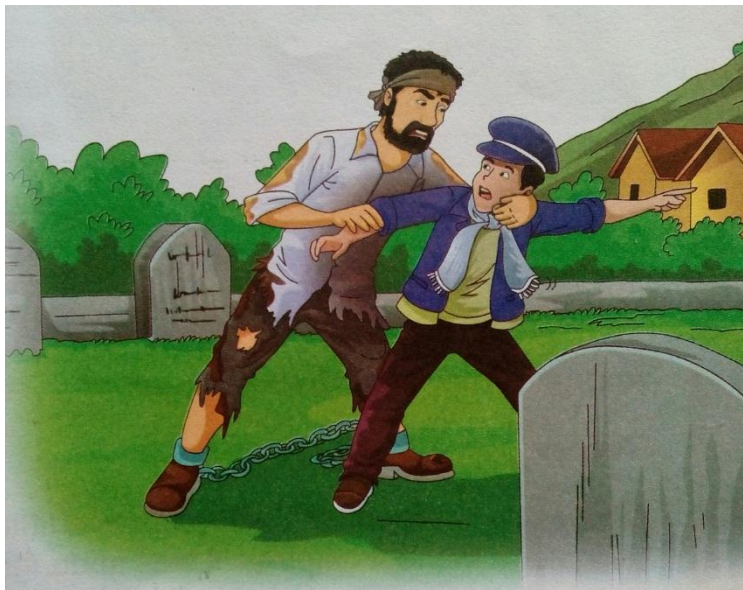

*Nouns that are the names of things, people, etc which can be counted are known as **Countable Nouns.***

*Nouns that are the names of things, people etc which cannot be counted are known as **Un-Countable Nouns.***
